To use the HHRI Learning Center, you will need a web browser that is HTML5 capable.

- ✓ Microsoft Internet Explorer 11
- ✓ Microsoft Edge
- ✓ Chrome version 60 or newer
- ✓ Firefox version 57 or newer
- ✓ Safari version 11.1 or newer

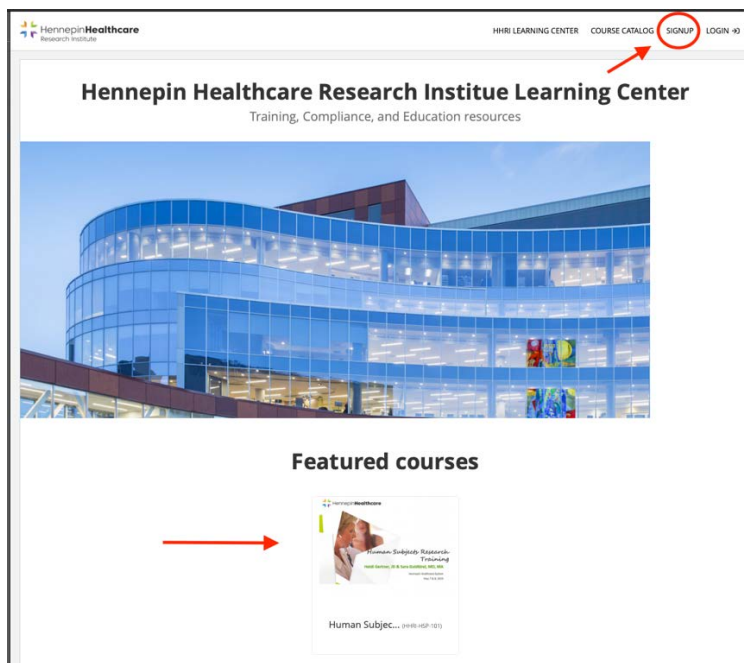
OR you will need to have Adobe Flash installed







Once you create your account, you will be taken to your **Home** page, and can select a course from the course catalog.







Human Subjects protection course

The course is divided into 5 sections: *Introductions* and four learning modules:

1. *Human Subjects Protection*
2. *Review of Study Designs*
3. *Review of Consent Waivers*
4. *Research requiring INDs and IDEs*

Each learning module is a 45 min to 1 hour video presentation followed by 4-5 quiz questions. You do not need to complete all the modules in one online session. You must complete learning modules 1-4 to complete the course.



If you complete a module and log off, you'll be prompted "*Do you want to resume where you left off?*" the next time you log in. **IMPORTANT: If you log off before completing a module, you'll need to restart that module from the beginning the next time you log in.**

Video presentation

During the video part of the module, you can use the navigation slider to go forward and backward in the presentation.


NOTE: if you click **NEXT**, this takes you to the Quiz part of the module and you'll need to restart the module to get back to the video.

When you complete the modules 1-4, you'll see your score.

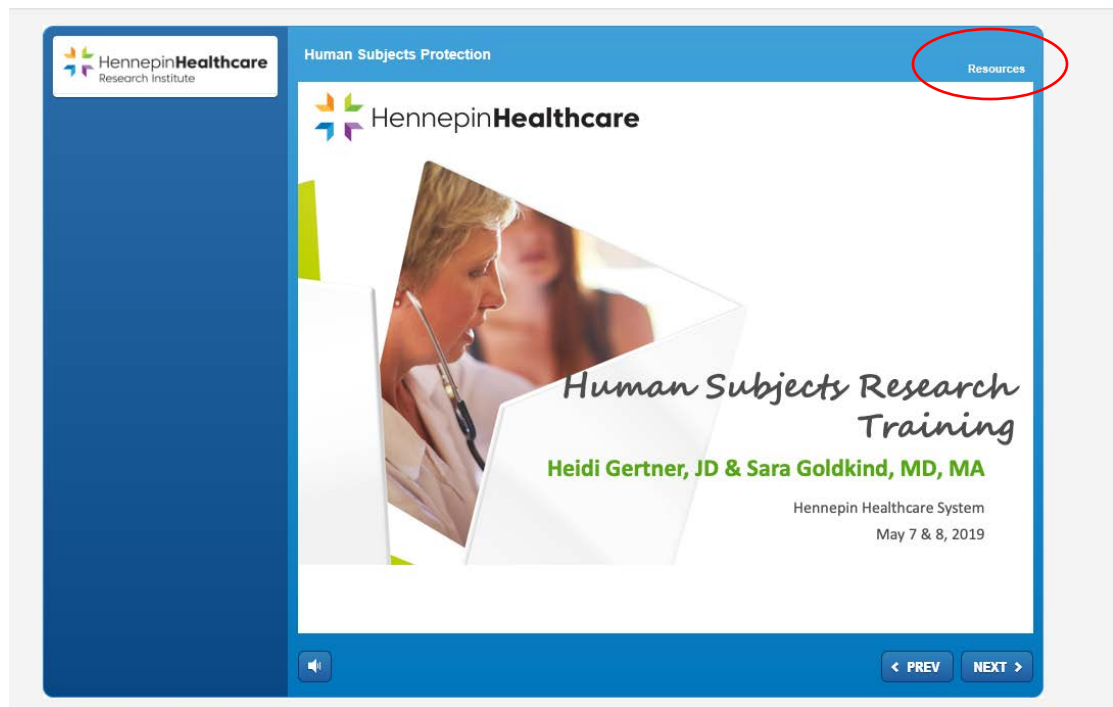
